- and more

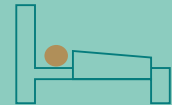
Penryith Apartments is also close to parks and open spaces for residents to enjoy. With good travel links, residents can easily access Kingston, Wimbledon and Sutton.

# People we support at Penryith Apartments

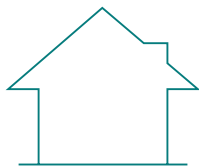
Residents living at Penryith Apartments are supported by highly trained and qualified staff. This will enable us to build rapport, understand their needs, and work with them in developing their skills for independence.

Promoting tailored care and autonomy to help residents' achieve their respective target milestones.

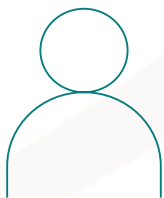

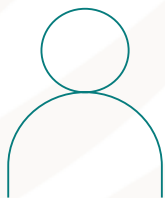
# A Caring Expert Team

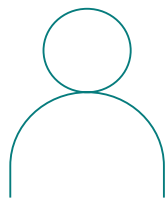

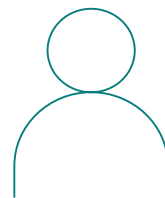
